Ken DeHart is a master player, teacher, coach, speaker and mentor based in San Jose, California. One of only four Master Professionals in both the USPTA (United States Professional Tennis Association) and PTR (Professional Tennis Registry), he is a USA High Performance Coach, USTA National Trainer for Recreational Coaches, and a USTA Trainer for Cardio Tennis. He is also a Continuing Education Speaker for the USTA, USPTA and PTR.

DeHart has over 30 years of experience as a player. He began as MVP for his U.S. college team, and recent distinctions have included a Gold medal in the Huntsman World Senior Games in Men's 50 & 55 singles, a Gold in the PTR International 55 Men's Doubles, and a Silver in the PTR International 55 Men's Singles.

DeHart is currently the Director of Tennis at the San Jose Swim & Racquet Club in San Jose, California, and he travels and speaks to tennis professionals across the U.S. as a Wilson Racquet Sports Premier Advisory Staff member.

As a featured speaker at the Victoria Tennis Festival, DeHart will talk from 6-7 PM on Friday, May 6 at Henderson Recreation Centre on the topic "Keeping Tennis Fun and Simple is a Key to Learning and Enjoying the Game."
