All Welcome (2.5 to 5.0+)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All players can play these events • Includes beginners (2.5) and novice players (3.5) • Includes Open (5.0+) events for top players vying for prize money • Includes top juniors challenging “adult” players • Includes more “social” mixed doubles 	May 5-7
Juniors (U10, U12, U14)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Younger junior events • Only a few tournaments have the under 10 years of age event (U10) • Under 14 years of age event (U14) is the only BC tournament outside lower mainland as an Outdoor National Qualifier for U14; first in the circuit; helps determine who represents BC in the Outdoor Nationals in the summer; new “Ludo” draw format 	May 12-14
Masters (35+ to 65+), WC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All players must be over the age of 35 years (35+), also 45+, 55+ and 65+ • Victoria, not surprisingly, has quite a few masters players • New category is 100+ Mixed Doubles (ages together add over 100 years) • Also wheelchair events (WC), same rules but two bounces allowed 	May 26-28
Juniors (U16, U18)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Older junior events • Only BC tournament outside lower mainland as an Outdoor National Qualifier • Helps determine who represents BC in the Outdoor Nationals in the summer • Some top juniors in this age bracket also play “Open” events 	June 2-4
